The ultimate peer-to-peer, multi platform conferencing software. Enabling LAN users to chat globally and privately, share files, video and audio stream, use a global whiteboard and to create/ participate in polls.

Profile and Room Creation/ Selection





Individual profiles can be saved and loaded using the Profile creation when jSummit starts. After a profile is created the available summits on the network can be accessed and joined, or a user can create a new summit with ease.

Window List


jSummit provides an easy to use interface of windows currently opened by the package. Users can simply click on a item in the window list to have it brought to the front and center of their desktop for ease of use.

Help and Configuration

Current config options, such as current profile and summit can be accessed and viewed. An easy jSummit help frame can be brought up that helps the user with the simple aspects of jSummit.

Whiteboard




The global whiteboard is used to allow users to draw graphical diagrams, load images to the canvas and make notes. Each user can add their own elements to the whiteboard for all to view. When a user leaves the summit a current copy of the whiteboard canvas can be saved.

File Sharing





Users can send files to multiple users through the File Sharing interface. Up to 11 files can be sent/ received at the same time, with a status bar indication of the progress of each file transfer.



The main GUI window displays the menu (File, Edit, Help), a list of currently open windows (Poll/Vote Creation, Configuration, Audio Controls, Shared Whiteboards, Help Frame), a global chat window with a message from 'Newbie', and a user list on the right showing online and away users with actions like 'Ignore User/s' and 'Boot User/s'.

Video and Audio

Users can have a one-one video conference with another user using the RTP protocol after establishing a link through the core. The video aspect of this conference can be disabled so only an audio conference is created.

Private Chat



After selecting a user from the User List, jSummit provides a private chatting interface, where users can talk to one another confidentially. It also enables multiple chats to be open at the same time and has an easy to use interface.

User List

Client information can easily be accessed by using the User List which also is used to send a list of users to a specific module. Users can also be ignored by right clicking on the selection in the list and choosing Ignore.


Global Chat

The chat on the MainGui enables a global conference between all members of the summit. As the summit closes down, a log of this chat is stored as a text file for easy re-access.

Server Functions

Owners of a summit can not only ignore users but also boot unwanted users from a summit or in the extreme case ban them so that they can not rejoin the summit.

Polling



Polls can be created with ease by the polling module that enables users to create a poll and send it to all participants of the summit. Users can then answer the poll or ignore it whilst the author waits a specified amount of time for the results. It is a quick and easy to use single interface that combines creating and answering polls in one.
